Whether you are looking to start or upskill for the sugar industry, or other industry sector, CQUniversity Australia can help you by providing training in MSL30118 Certificate III in Laboratory Skills.

This mid-level qualification covers the skills and knowledge required to perform a range of laboratory operations across all industry sectors and is the entry level required for laboratory personnel across all industry sectors.



COURSE INFORMATION

Entry requirements: There are no specific entry requirements under the training package for this qualification

Pre-enrolment requirement for all students: Students are required to complete the Basic Key Skills Builder online literacy and numeracy assessment, or to provide a certificate copy of a completed equal-level or higher-level course

Intake Dates for new student admissions: **Standard Course** February and July; **Sugar Stream** November

Study Mode: Online learning and two weeks of compulsory residentials at CQUni's Mackay Ooralea Campus

- ❖ **Standard Course:** Online with residentials held in May and November
- ❖ **Sugar Stream:** Online with residentials held in May.

Number of Units: 13 units – 6 core units and 7 electives

Duration: Competency-based training can be completed sooner than the stated duration if the required skill levels have been met for each unit under the qualification. Students studying part time may take longer to complete.

- ❖ **Standard Course** is one year
- ❖ **Sugar Stream** Students wanting to study outside of the Cane Season Harvest period can fast track by early enrolment in the Sugar Cluster in November, followed by Cluster 1 (Feb), Cluster 2 (March), and Cluster 3 (April), as outlined in the Course Planner on page 2, with a May two week compulsory residential school
- ❖ RPL** and Credit Transfer are also available for eligible applicants

Full course cost: \$4 550, \$350 per unit

Subsidised Co-contribution Fee: \$1 079, \$83.00 per unit*

Subsidised Concession Fee: \$274, \$19 per unit*
